Beyond these fenced areas lies some fairly level grassy terrain and much more open country - hilly, rolling terrain fit for a challenging cross country jumping course. There was room for spectator parking close-in and trailer parking a bit further away.

Business Meeting

Thereafter we adjourned to the house for refreshments and a meeting convened by President Julie Daniels at about 7:30 p.m. to discuss possible dates and times of future club meetings, possible mounted activities for members, and the approaching recognized show.

The show discussion included the current paucity of entries, people volunteering to help transport, set-up and tear-down the dressage arena and judges stand, other jobs, and supplies to

be provided. Discussion also included how the announcers (We have three!!) could help with spectator control (very noisy running in the bleachers) and reminders to patronize Kennisons' Katering, and to respond when other help is needed. No final action was taken on any issue.
