****Heeled boots and approved helmets with safety strap are required for all classes. Western saddles may be used for classes 1,2,3,4.**

Concessions available on show grounds as a fund raiser for Fort Caspar Pony Club.

Awards 1-6 in all classes for each age group

Classes will be divided into Junior (18 and under) and Senior (over 18)

May enter the morning of the show starting at 7:30 a.m. Separate entry form required for each horse/rider. Release must be completed and signed for each competitor.

Jumper classes will include an initial jumping round. Those with no faults in the initial round will jump a shortened course that is timed. The fastest time with the fewest faults in the timed portion is the winner. Each section must be entered separately.

1. Pile of Poles Course A: Beginner Riders-Riders may be led over the jumps, may not enter any other jumping class except low x-rails. Western saddle may be used
