- Sue Gentle made a motion to donate \$1000 to On the Bit's recognized show, 2nd by Sue Basham.
- Diane also suggested a donation to the disaster relief need for NE flood victims. Cheryl Mair will check on the best place to make a donation, what is needed most and report at next meeting.

Old Business:

Diane was not able to contact Jane, but from her email it sounds like possibly 45 min private lessons or 15 min shorter sessions with Kathleen Donnelly is a possible solution. And instead of a schooling show, just have a ride-a-test. It was decided to chair further discussion until next meeting and finalize then.
