

## Minutes for the CDEC March 15 meeting

**Those in attendance:** Otis & LaNita Lovercheck, Bill & Sue Gentle, Deeda Randall, Becky O'Leary, Diane Wenzel, Kim Giffin Guest: Kellie Thomson

**Meeting was called to order** at 6:45 p.m. by Diane Wenzel. Diane welcomed everyone and Kellie introduced herself and members introduced themselves.

### Old Business:

- **Minutes for the February** meeting were approved. Kim so moved and Sue seconded.
- **Treasurer's report:** Sue shared that since January \$185.00 in dues has been collected. The checking account has \$7395.69. Becky asked how we stood financially right now, before the recognized show, as compared in past years. Sue said we were about the same.
- **By-Laws revisions** were approved as written. Sue so moved and Deeda seconded.
- **CDEC inventory list:** Kim had gone to Jane's and picked up the remaining ribbons, glasses, and jump numbers. The jump flags and the judges table still need to be picked up. Diane will update the inventory list and noted that she has most all the items at her house.
- **Club meeting locations:** Otis reported that the Airport is no longer allowing meeting there. Lanita reported that LCCC charges \$25/hour for one of their rooms. Kim offered to check with Uncle Charlies for use of their upstairs room.

### New Business:

- **Recognized Show update:** Deeda reported that the class list is due in April or May. The recognized show is June 9 & 10. She has contracts for Eleanor (Ellie) Stine Masek, Judge for Saturday show, Laurie Mactavish, TD, & Mike Taylor, Show Secretary, and waiting on a contract with Brent Hicks, Judge for Sunday show. Deeda also shared that Ellie is qualified to judge western dressage and she will check with Ellie about judging the schooling show being planned for Friday, June 8, from 9a.m. to 3p.m. Diane shared that if we want to have the western dressage rides recognized, the cost is only \$15.00. We will need scribes and a gate person for the schooling show, just the same as for the recognized show. Diane offered that if Mike cannot take care of the entries for the schooling show, she and Kim would do it. After more discussion Diane moved and Sue seconded that we have the schooling show which will be a test of choice including classical dressage and western dressage. Motion passed. The indoor warmup arena will be available for the Saturday contestants after the schooling show. Deeda will check with Arleen at LCCC to see if we can set up the dressage arena Thursday evening.
- Deeda also reported that Frontier Veterinary Clinic will be the veterinarian on call. She will check with Adam Tallman about being farrier again. There was discussion about how dry the ground of the outside warmup arena is. It was suggested the A1 Rental might provide a water truck and that the fire departments are always looking for places to dump excess water they deal with. We discussed who to check with about being a vendor for the show. Kim suggested that since Connie Woodruff, Wyoming Tack Room, was the vendor last year, ask her first. If she can't do it, then ask Jen Wright, Happy

Horse Tack & Saddle Shop. Deeda asked for recommendation for hotels for judges, etc. Suggestions were made and Deeda will check on it. Deeda expressed concerns that judges want 2 days of judging work and next year we have conflicts with other shows, so CDEC will have to discuss this at a later time.

- **Ride-a-test:** Kim shared that she has asked Jane if she would hold a ride-a-test at her place and Jane had indicated she would. It will need to be held in May, before the recognized show. Kim will get back with her about that.
- **Silent Auction and sponsors:** Kim will be collecting the items and putting the display up at the show. Sue reported that she had an anonymous sponsor of \$500.00, Larry Sutherland is sponsoring with \$500.00 and Meridian Trust is sponsoring with \$500.00. Everyone needs to get sponsors. Even \$25.00 sponsor are helpful. LaNita reported that, for the silent auction, Dakota Haller will provide a chiropractic service and Patrick Guillory will provide 2 bags of Chaffehaye and some other samples items. As you get items, contact Kim so she can pick items up. Kim also needs the information on the sponsors as she will prepare the program. Kim will check with Christy Rawlings about getting that set up and printed.
- **Future programs & activities:** Diane would like to plan a trail ride or something like that. We had a discussion and suggestions made but finally decided that it would be best to wait until after the recognized show before we get into other activities. Sue also shared that our insurance is being transferred to another company, but in the past when we had an extra activity; it cost \$25.00 to add it to our insurance for coverage.

**Meeting Adjourned:** Becky moved and Sue seconded the adjournment of the meeting at 8:45p.m. Motion passed.

**Non-Club event:** Following the meeting, those interested discussed a tack sale to be held at the Gentle's on Saturday, April 14 in their indoor arena. It will be held from 9a.m. until 2p.m. Each participant is responsible for setting up, taking care of their sales, and taking down & clearing out when the sale time is over. Each participant is their own vendor. Sue suggested that you put a tarp down for your display area. Set up can be done Friday evening or before 9 on Saturday morning. Sue will design a poster for the event that can be shared. Contact Sue if you plan to take part.
